



How to do your CBS Lesson...

Pray for a willing spirit and a teachable heart. You can't understand everything at once, but God does have an important truth for you today. If you ask, He will give you all the understanding that you need.

Open your BIBLE. The CBS lessons are written from the NIV (New International Version), but any translation will work, and all are helpful.

Spend time with God every day. The lessons are divided into 5 days because we need to spend time with God every day. Whether you do your lesson this way or not, do try to spend time in His Word every day.

Put God's Word in your heart by memorizing the verse of the week.

Read the whole passage for the week's lesson before beginning the questions. Then read the verses for each section as you come to them.

Answer the question from the existing passage first and then look to cross references for more help.

Record the verses where you find your answers for future reference. If a verse has an asterisk* after it, it means to hold onto this reference because you will need it again for future questions.

***** is for deeper study.** You can look up a word in your concordance in the back of your Bible to find more verses on a topic. You can also look in your margin or at the bottom of the page of your Bible to find more cross references.

>>> Means you can dig even deeper by answering the questions on the last page of the commentary.

Listen to your Core Group. You will all learn from each other as you talk about your new insights.

Read the CBS Commentary. It will help clear up your questions.

Live it! Ask God to show you how each truth applies to your own life, and to help you live out what you have learned. God will bless you for studying The Bible!
